- **Greenhouse:** preparation of seeding mix, seeding and potting up.
- **Field:** transplanting, weeding, pruning and pest control.
- **Machinery Operation:** Tractor and implement utilisation (training provided).
- **Market Style Drop-off:** Helping clients, stocking produce, ect.

Eligibility for Agricultural Youth Green Jobs Initiative (*must meet all criteria*)

- Be Canadian youth.
- Be 30 years or younger, including high school students when they start the internship.
- Be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident.
- Must not have participated in any other Youth Employment Strategy programs (that is, Career Focus).

Qualifications

- Belief in the values of organic agriculture.
- Ability to work fast and a drive to improve efficiency.
- Good physical condition.
- Ability to work well with others.
- Ease with the public.
- Bilingualism is an asset but not required.
- Driver's license is an asset but not required.
- A good attitude and sense of humour.

Job Details

- **Start/End Date:** late April to late October (there is some flexibility with these dates)
- **Work Schedule:** 40-48 hours/week: Monday to Friday, and occasional weekend work
- **Wage:** \$12.00/hour, minus source deductions (EI, QPP, QPIP, etc.)
